ATHLETICS FOR SCHOOLBOYS

The Department of Child Hygiene of the Russell Sage Foundation has collected considerable material on athletics for schoolboys. It shows how athletics which are often detrimental to school work and a nuisance to the community may become an aid to physical development and help to improve the character of the boys both in school and on the street.

Emphasis is also laid on special forms of athletics known as "Class Athletics" and "Athletic Badge Tests" which are designed to reach all the boys instead of a selected few.

To cover the cost of printing and shipping, a nominal charge of five cents per pamphlet, or \$2.50 per hundred for quantities is made.

Lantern slides with printed descriptions for use at public meetings are loaned free of charge. The borrower pays express charges.
