# SOUTHERN MOUNTAIN SCHOOLS MAINTAINED BY DENOMINATIONAL AND INDEPENDENT AGENCIES

In 1921 the Foundation published a directory of Southern Highland Schools, compiled by Mrs. Olive D. Campbell. This soon went out of print and in response to numerous requests for up-to-date information the following tentative list has been prepared. In addition to the schools of the Southern Appalachian region, several schools located in the Ozark Mountains have been included.

This list covers only those schools which exist primarily for the southern mountaineer and which are carried on under other than public auspices. It has been compiled entirely on data supplied by the school authorities and while other schools are known to exist, only those which have responded to requests for information have been included.

It is hoped that enough additional information will be sent in to make possible a practically complete directory.
