STATEMENT OF SCIENTIFIC

INTENT

My work primarily focuses on understanding the processes and mechanisms shaping integration/assimilation trajectories among the children of immigrants in Western societies. I am currently investigating three analytical dimensions of integration and their interrelation: socioeconomic attainment and intergenerational mobility (structural integration); intergroup ties and diversification in social networks (relational integration); cultural difference, belonging and the assignment of worth to minority others (symbolic/cultural integration). Methodologically, I primarily use a combination of statistical modeling, automated classification techniques, and in-depth interviewing.
