Appendix to Chapter 4

Samples

For educational attainment regressions, the sample used in this chapter includes all New York and Los Angeles respondents ages 23 and above with at least one foreign born parent, excluding Puerto Ricans. All group level variables are multiple imputed. Observations missing data on any individual level variable are listwise deleted.

For occupational attainment regressions, the sample used in this chapter includes all New York and Los Angeles respondents ages 25 and above with at least one foreign born parent, excluding Puerto Ricans. All group level variables are multiple imputed. Observations missing data on any individual level variable are listwise deleted.

Variables specific to chapter 4

- Country of Origin: Models include dummy variables indicating parent place of birth which is assigned in the same fashion as our measures of group-level characteristics. Where the country of birth of one parent is missing, the respondent is assigned the country of birth of the parent with complete information. Where two foreign born parents have different countries of birth, the mothers country of birth is assigned. Where one parent is US born, the foreign born parents country of birth is assigned. Models include the following set of dummy variables: Dominican Republic; Guatemala; El Salvador; Jamaica; China; Colombia; Korea; Philippines; Ecuador; Vietnam; Russia
- This chapter further included an indicator for whether the respondent was separated from a parent for at least one year or more before the age of 18.

Models

The group level dummy model was conducted using multiple regression with the MI prefix in Stata 14. All other models were conducted using hierarchical linear models with the mixed command and the MI prefix in Stata 14.

- Supplementary education: IIMMLA: attended a weekend school or after school program to learn a specific language other than English; ISGMNY: participated in cram school/ private tutoring
- Used public amenities (ISGMNY): We measured use of public amenities as a combination of reports to using libraries and museums during childhood. Respondents could answer that they used libraries or museums ?a lot?, ?sometimes? or ?never?. We grouped together those who used both amenities ?a lot? (8%), those who used at least one ?a lot? (41%), and combined those who used libraries or museums only ?sometimes? (49%) with the remaining 2% who never did.

Sample

The analysis of citizenship density draws on both surveys. For descriptive statistics we restrict the surveys to an identical age range (20 to 33) but in the multivariate analysis use the full sample controlling for age differences. The event history analysis of time to naturalization draws only on the 1.5 generation subsample of the IIMMLA survey. In addition, we drop 27 cases that show up as having US citizenship at time of arrival.

Variables specific to chapter 6

- Number of citizens in household (pooled survey): Both surveys contain information on the citizenship status of the respondent and the parents. We aggregated this information in to a sum ranging from 0 to 3 that indicated the citizenship density in that subset of the household
- Timing of naturalization (1.5 generation IIMMLA sample only): A variable indicating how many years after arrival in the US a respondent naturalized.

Models

To model the number of citizens in a household (from 0 to 3) we use a mixed effects poisson regression. Since there is a clear upper-bound to the number of citizens a binomial regression would be the optimal choice, but to our knowledge there is no implementation of this model in a Mixed-effects modelling framework. We conducted a number of tests which indicate that the choice is not consequential for the results (coefficients for individual level variables are substantively identical). However, due to the multilevel nature of our data and the critical part the group-level coefficients play in our analysis we opt for the multilevel approach. To model the timing of naturalization of 1.5 generation respondents in the HMMLA survey we use a discrete-time event history analysis approach and employ a mixed-effects logistic regression model. All models included the MI prefix in Stata 14.

Samples

As most measures of political participation were not commensurable between the two surveys, the majority of the chapter draws on the IIMMLA survey exclusively. Only for the analysis of partisanship did we pool the samples. We generally use the full age range (20-40). For some outcomes such as voting and party registration we restricted the analysis to citizens, omitting non-naturalized 1.5 generation respondents.

Variables specific to chapter 7

The dependent variables for the various aspects of political participation are described in the chapter (table 7.1).

Models

For the analyses of civic and political participation we used mixed-effects logistic regressions with the MI prefix. The following table shows the full set of regression results. For the analyses of party registration we used multinomial logistic regressions. As a multilevel version of this analysis was not feasible to implement we relied on clustering to adjust standard errors with the MI prefix in Stata.

Samples

The first set of analyses draws on the pooled dataset which limits the number and granularity of independent and dependent variables. The remainder of the chapter draws in the IIMMLA data only which provides more detailed dependent and independent variables.

Variables specific to chapter 8

The dependent variables for this chapter are coded as follows:

- Visiting is coded into a five-category ordered variable; for the analysis of the pooled data this variable is collapsed into a binary. For the IIMMLA data analysis we have the following levels:
 - Never
 - Once
 - -2 to 5 times
 - -6 to 10 times
 - 11 or more times
- Remitting is coded into a five-category ordered variable. For the analysis of the pooled data we have to collapse this variable into a binary indicating never remitted vs everybody else.
 - Not at all
 - Once or twice
 - Yearly
 - Several times a year
 - Monthly or more frequently
- Feeling at home outside the US: A binary variable distinguishing all those who mention a country other than the US (either exclusively or together with the US) in response to the question which country feels most like home?
- Membership in Organization: Indicates those that are members in an organization that are concerned with the parental home-country of any of the parents.
- Interest in home country politics is a 4 point likert type scale response (strongly disagree to strongly agree) to the prompt "I am interested in the politics of my parents or grandparents home country."

Models

Mixed effects models are used, either binary logistic regressions or ordered logistic regression, as appropriate for the dependent variable. All analyses use the MI prefix in Stata.

Samples

For all analyses with language as the dependent variable, we use both Los Angeles and New York respondents with at least one foreign born parent, 18 and older, with complete information on language ability and preference and we omit respondents from countries where English is an official language. For analyses with cross-border ties, we restrict our analysis to the Los Angeles sample only. Sample sizes for these analyses are noted in the tables below.

Variables specific to chapter 9

As mentioned in the chapter, the IIMMLA survey asked respondents a series of open-ended questions about ethnic labels they use to describe themselves. In a series of steps we coded these open-ended responses first standardizing them and then coding them assigning them to a set of categories including Hyphenated-American (e.g. Chinese-American, Mexican-American), National-Origin (e.g. Mexican, Salvadoran) or Pan-ethnic/Racial categories (e.g. Asian, Latino). We also use information on which of the labels the respondent preferred.

Models

Language ability is modelled using mixed effect regression, and language preference is modelled with random effects logistic regression. Acculturation type is modelled with multinomial logistic regression. Preference for ethnic labels is modelled with a series of mixed effects logistic regressions. All estimations use the MI prefix in Stata.
