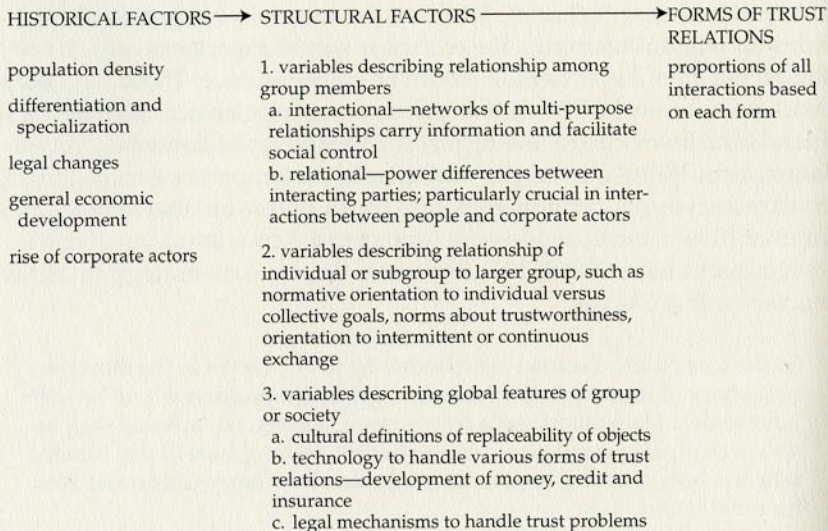


Figure 2.1 Historical Change, Structural Factors and Forms of Trust Relations
